

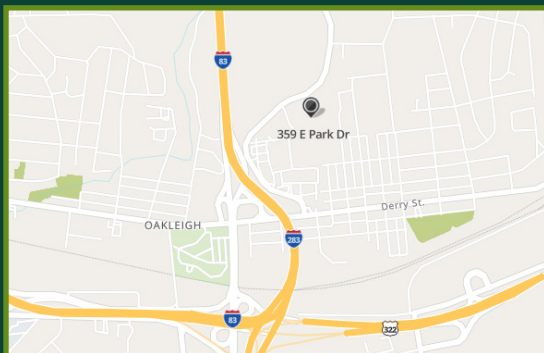

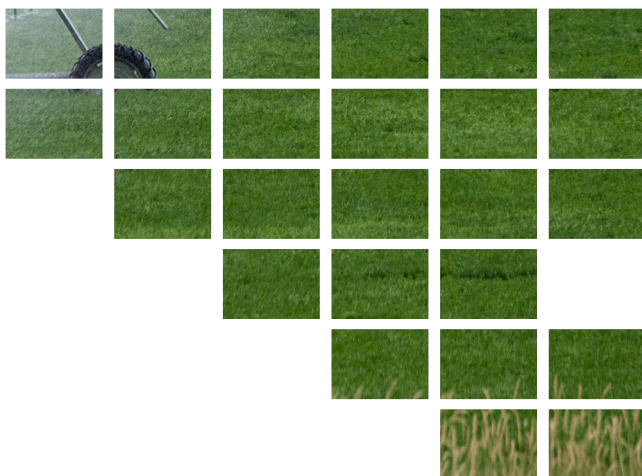
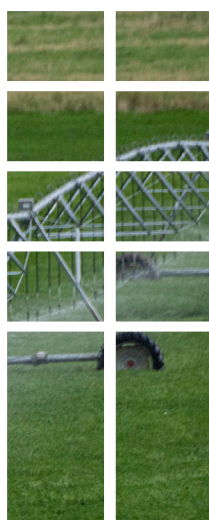

## What is the State Technical Committee?

The State Technical Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) on the implementation of natural resources conservation provisions of Farm Bill legislation. Chaired by the NRCS State Conservationist, the Committee is comprised of representatives from federal and state natural resource agencies, agricultural producers, and other individuals who represent a variety of disciplines related to soil, water, air, and wildlife.



## How Can Committee Members Help?

Committee members:

- Provide information, analysis, and recommendations to USDA on conservation priorities and criteria for natural resources conservation activities and programs, including application and funding criteria, recommended practices, and program payment.
- Identify emerging natural resource concerns and program needs.
- Recommend Pennsylvania NRCS and national program policy based on resource data.
- Recommend conservation practice standards and specifications.
- Make recommendations to the State Conservationist on requests and recommendations from local working groups.
- Assist NRCS with public outreach and communication efforts to all producers, including minorities, and identify educational and training needs.

## How Are State Technical Committee Meetings Conducted?

State Technical Committee meetings are conducted as an open discussion among members. The public is invited to attend.

Individuals participating in the meetings have the opportunity to address the committee and present their opinions and recommendations. The State Conservationist may assemble certain members into subcommittees to discuss, examine, and focus on a particular technical or programmatic topic. The subcommittees will report back to during a State Technical Committee meeting. All recommendations will be considered in a public meeting.
