



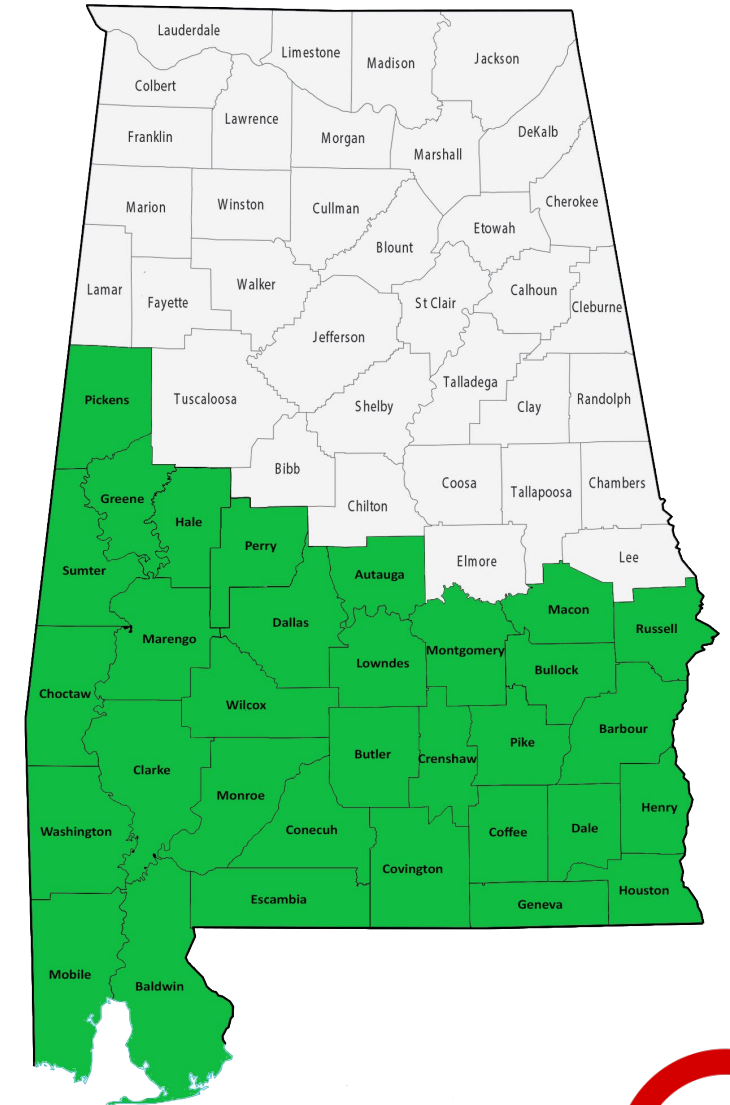

CIP FY 2025 Feral Swine Exclusion Fencing



Who, Where and When

- 32 Counties are eligible from the Central, Black Belt, and Southern portions of the state for feral swine exclusion fencing rebates
- Purpose is to incentivize landowners to restrict feral swine access and impacts to food production operations
- 36% of grantees must meet Historically Underserved criteria
- Property to be fenced must be part of an agricultural operation but can be an unincorporated non-profit
- \$480,000 in conservation incentive funds made available through NACD grant to ALSWCC



Basic Parameters

- Will provide for exclusion of feral swine to areas of up to 20 acres or the amount enclosed in 5000 linear feet of fence per application at maximum (whichever limit is reached first)
- 5-wire high tensile electric fencing only under this grant
- 8 joule energizer or greater with appropriate grounding and solar or battery backup as specified by NRCS
- No woven wire or barbed wire fencing allowed
- Adheres to the new NRCS Construction Specification 382 for High Tensile Use Exclusion Fence for Feral Swine
- Paid per linear foot in accordance with NRCS EQIP 382 Permanent Electric Fence rates upon completion (includes a standard and historically underserved rate)



- Outreach begins August 2024
- Outreach, applications, assessments, and construction inspection provided by Andrew Williams, Darrell McGuire, John Lewis (TUCCA), and Josh Harrison (Houston SWCD)
- Project file and payment administration provided by local SWCD and ALSWCC
- Application period officially begins October 1st 2024
- 1st batch approval planned by November 30th
- CPA-52 and CRRs are required
