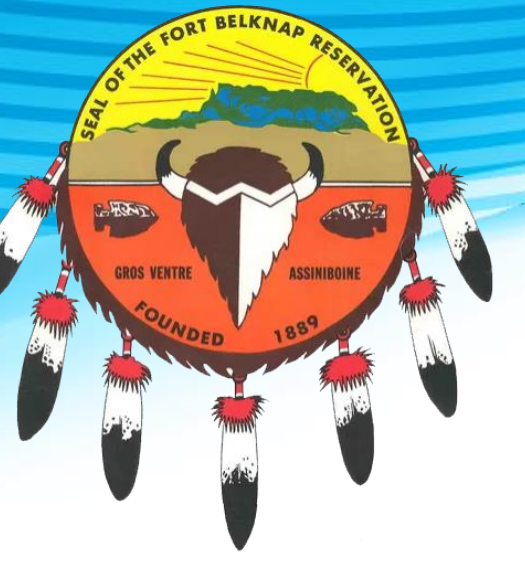

What Will the Watershed Plan-EA Include?

CONTENT	DESCRIPTION
Background Information	Sponsor, cooperating agencies, consulting parties, and study area
Purpose & Need for the Project	- Identified problems for the project to address and associated opportunities - Planning objectives and constraints (limitations)
Affected Environment	- Current environmental, economic, and social conditions in the watershed - Projected future conditions in the watershed
Development of Alternatives	- Alternatives development process - Alternatives considered and alternatives considered but eliminated - Summary of alternatives
Environmental Consequences	- Evaluation of environmental, economic, and social effects of each alternative - Comparison of alternatives
Preferred Alternative	- Identification of preferred alternative - Costs of implementation - Permits and approvals for implementation
Consultation, Coordination, & Public Participation	- Summary of consultation with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Tribe, and State Historic Preservation Office - Summary of coordination with interested federal, state, and local agencies, including comments and responses to comments received - Summary of public outreach activities, including comments and responses to comments received
