**General CRP Signup:** General CRP signup 62 was held from March 4, 2024, through March 29, 2024. Land not currently enrolled in CRP was eligible to be offered for enrollment during general CRP signup 62. In addition, CRP participants with a contract scheduled to expire on September 30, 2024, were eligible submit an offer for land enrolled under contract. Contracts approved will have a contract beginning on October 1, 2024.

**CCRP/CLEAR/FWP/HELI/SAFE/CREP CRP Signup:** The Further Continuing Appropriations and Other Extensions Act, 2024 was signed by the President on November 17, 2023, and included a 1-year extension of the 2018 Farm Bill re-authorizing CRP through September 30, 2024. As a result, unless legislation is enacted to re-authorize or extend FSA's authority to deliver CRP, no offers may be processed after September 30, 2024.

Notice CRP-1007 restricted processing of all new offers and approval of all new CRP contracts for all signup types after September 30, 2023.

Notice CRP-1016 dated January 9, 2024, provided authorities and guidance for County Offices and COC's to begin accepting offers and approving contracts under all continuous signup initiatives, including CREP.

The 2018 Farm Bill requires that no more than 27 million acres can be enrolled in CRP. Enrollment in CRP at the time of the release of Notice CRP-1016 approximately 24.7 million acres. Contracts totaling approximately 482,527 acres were scheduled to expire on September 30, 2024.

To prioritize acres for CRP enrollment and ensure that acreage enrolled does not exceed the statutory limitation, beginning January 12, 2024, FSA established a national CRP offer batching process for CCRP/CLEAR/FWP/HELI/SAFE offers.

- The deadline to offer CCRP/CLEAR/FWP/HELI/SAFE signup 61 reenrolled land or new land offers that included reenrolled land was July 31, 2024. All new land offers were accepted through September 30, 2024.
- All CCRP/CLEAR/FWP/HELI/SAFE signup 61 offers received after July 31, 2024, were not batched.
- MN CREP is subject to BWSR batching periods, however, was not subject to National FSA batching period. All CREP offers were accepted through September 30, 2024.

**Emergency Conservation Program (ECP):** ECP Flood was implemented in Nobles County in 2024 for practice EC3 Replacing or Restoring Permanent Fences.

**Snowmobile Trails on CRP:** MN Notice CRP-432 Snowmobile Trails on Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Land was released August 19, 2024.

This notice provided FSA County Offices:

- CRP policy County FSA Offices shall follow when processing requests for utilizing CRP land for snowmobile trails.

If an authorized use request is approved, allowing the use of snowmobile trails on CRP, the following applies:

- An authorized use request must be made on a yearly basis.
- Snowmobile trails on CRP will be allowed between October 1 and March 31, provided the snowpack is at least 5 inches and the activity would cause no long-term damage to the vegetative cover on the land, determined on a contract-by-contract basis.
- An inspection of the CRP to ensure cover integrity will occur in the spring, no later than May 15th.
- The participant must agree in writing to re-establish, at their own expense, any cover destroyed or damaged as a result of snowmobile trails.
- A list of CRP contracts that, in previous years, may have allowed State and/or Club groomed snowmobile trails on CRP.
- A letter County Offices shall provide to CRP contract shareholders with greater than zero percent that have been identified as utilizing CRP for snowmobile trails.
- Language that may be used to notify participants through GovDelivery.
