

RIVERVIEW TERRACE FLOOD RESPONSE

REDUCING RISK – CONNECTING COMMUNITY – ENHANCING HABITAT



The Riverview Terrace neighborhood lies within the Pocasset River watershed. Residential, industrial, and commercial development over the years has resulted in major flood risks in this low-lying neighborhood.

This project aims to combine voluntary buyouts and historic floodplain restoration to increase community flood resilience, create more green space, and restore habitat.

The image at right shows expected flood levels for the current 100-year storm. In the future, these flood levels are expected to increase as extreme rainfall events become more common. Computer models predict the following flood levels for the neighborhood:

- Riverview Terrace Condominiums: ~2.6 feet max
- Intersection of Fordson and Davis Ave: ~4.4 feet max
- Entrance to Davis Ct: ~4.8 feet max
