



Pathways Programs

The USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) offers internships for high school students and degree-seeking undergraduate and graduate students studying science and agriculture, management, business, technology and many other fields. We also offer programs for recent graduates from qualifying institutions. Read about the two career Pathways Programs for students and recent graduates.

Internship Program

The Internship Program provides paid work experiences for students who are in high school or pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in an accredited college or university (including Home-Schooling, Certificate Programs, and Community Colleges). Interns may work during the summer, fall, spring, or year round.

Recent Graduates Program

The Recent Graduates Program provides individuals who have recently graduated from qualifying educational institutions or programs with developmental experiences in the Federal Government that are intended to promote possible careers in the civil service. Participants must have obtained a degree or completed a qualifying career or technical education program within the preceding 2 years. Veterans are eligible to participate in the program within 6 years of obtaining a degree or graduating from a qualifying program.
