Illinois designated 8 high priority practices (HPP) eligible for an increased payment. The 8 practices are Constructed Wetland (656), Contour Buffer Strips (332), Denitrifying Bioreactor (605), Drainage Water Management (554), Filter Strip (393), Nutrient Management (590), Saturated Buffer (604), and Structure for Water Control (587). The HPP are available to all applicants. The HPP scenarios are prefaced with a "PR-" in the payment schedule. If the applicants/participants are HU, the HU scenario must be used instead of the "PR-".													
Illinois designated 10 source water protection practices for an increased payment rate in the 11 designated source water protection watersheds. The 10 practices are Constructed Wetland (656), Denitrifying Bioreactor (605), Drainage Water Management (554), Filter Strip (393), Grassed Waterway (412), Irrigation and Drainage Tailwater Recovery (447), Nutrient Management (590), Pest Management Conservation System (595), Saturated Buffer (604), and Structure for Water Control (587). The source water protection practice scenarios are prefaced with a "WP-". If the applicants/participants are HU, the HU scenario must be used instead of the "WP-".
