Title VI of the Education Amendments Act of 1972 (Title VI) prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex, pregnancy or parental status, in educational programs and activities that receive Federal financial assistance. The law also prohibits individuals from exclusion from such programs or activities or from denial of benefits from such programs or activities based on sex. This prohibition applies to a wide array of public and private entities at the local, state, and federal levels, including all institutions of higher learning, which are controlled by a religious organization or which receive Federal funding. A school that is controlled by a religious organization is exempt from Title VI when the school's operations would conflict with the organization's religious beliefs. The law requires federally funded education institutions or programs to disseminate Title VI information widely, including the name, address, and telephone number (or other contact information) of the designated Title VI Coordinator.

Programs and activities are subject to language other than English. Persons with disabilities who require alternative means of communication (e.g., braille, large print, sign language, Braille or sign language) should contact the responsible State or local agency that administers the program or activity (USDA through the Federal Telecommunications Relay Service at 711, voice and TDD).

How to File a Title VI Complaint with USDA against an Institution, a potential complainant may want to first find out about the institution's grievance process and then that process to have the complaint resolved. However, a complainant is not required by law to use the institution's grievance process before filing a complaint with the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASACR). If a complainant uses an institution's grievance process and chooses to file the complaint with ASACR, the complainant must file with ASACR within 60 days after completion of the institution's grievance process.

To file a Title VI grievance discrimination complaint, a complainant should complete Form AS-3027, USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form, which can be obtained online at <https://www.usda.gov/officeofcivilrights/ASACR/ASACR-form-3027> or by calling (800) 422-9992, or by writing a letter addressed to the USDA office listed below.

The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to allow ASACR to determine the merits and date of an alleged civil rights violation. The completed AS-3027 Form or letter must be submitted to USDA only.

El Título VI de la Ley de Corrección de Educación de 1972 (Título VI) prohíbe la discriminación por motivos de sexo, embarazo o estado parental en los programas y actividades educativas que reciben asistencia financiera federal. La ley también prohíbe que los individuos sean excluidos de dichos programas o actividades o que les deneguen beneficios de dichos programas o actividades por motivos de sexo. Esta prohibición se aplica a una amplia gama de entidades públicas y privadas en los niveles de la escuela, la universidad, el gobierno estatal y federal, incluidas todas las instituciones de enseñanza superior y universidades que reciben fondos federales, que están controladas por una organización religiosa o que reciben fondos federales.

El Título VI requiere que las instituciones o programas educativos federales con fondos federales divulguen ampliamente la información del Título VI, incluyendo el nombre, la dirección y el número de teléfono (o otra información de contacto) del coordinador designado del Título VI.

La información del programa está disponible en otros idiomas además del inglés. Las personas con discapacidades que requieren medios de comunicación alternativos (p.ej., braille, letra grande, cinta de audio o lenguaje de señas) deberían contactar con la Agencia estatal local responsable que administra el programa o actividad con una oficina de trabajo del servicio federal de telecomunicaciones al 711 (voz y TDD).

Antes de presentar una queja del Título VI contra una institución, es recomendable que primero se encuentre el proceso de queja formal de la institución y se use ese proceso para resolver la queja. Sin embargo, la ley no exige que se utilice ese proceso de queja formal institucional antes de presentar una queja ante el ASACR. Si un reclamante usa un proceso de queja formal institucional y elige presentar la queja ante el ASACR, debe hacerlo dentro de los 60 días después de haber concluido el proceso de queja formal institucional.

Para presentar una queja por discriminación en el programa del USDA, el reclamante debe completar el formulario AS-3027, el formulario de queja por discriminación del programa del USDA, que se puede obtener en línea en <https://www.usda.gov/officeofcivilrights/ASACR/ASACR-form-3027> o llamando al (800) 422-9992, o escribiendo una carta dirigida a la oficina del ASACR que se indica abajo.

La carta debe contener el nombre, la dirección, el número de teléfono y una descripción escrita de la queja o acción discriminatoria con suficiente detalle para permitir al ASACR determinar los méritos y la fecha de la alegada violación de los derechos civiles. El formulario AS-3027 o la carta completa deben enviarse al USDA por correo.
